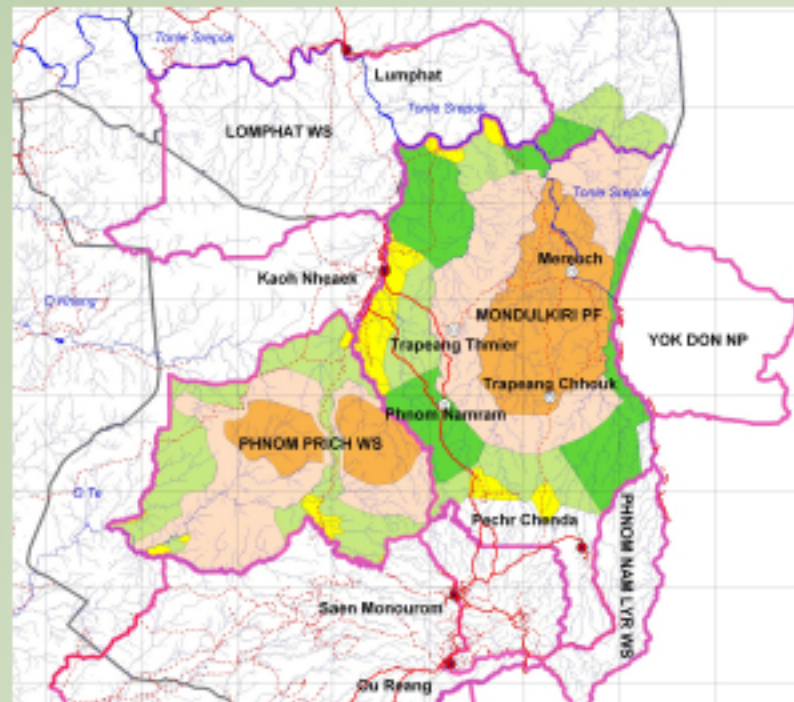

The Mondulkiri Protected Forest for Conservation of Genetic Resources of Plants and Wildlife was proclaimed via Sub-decree No: 75 ANK-BK of the Royal Government of Cambodia on 30 July, 2002.

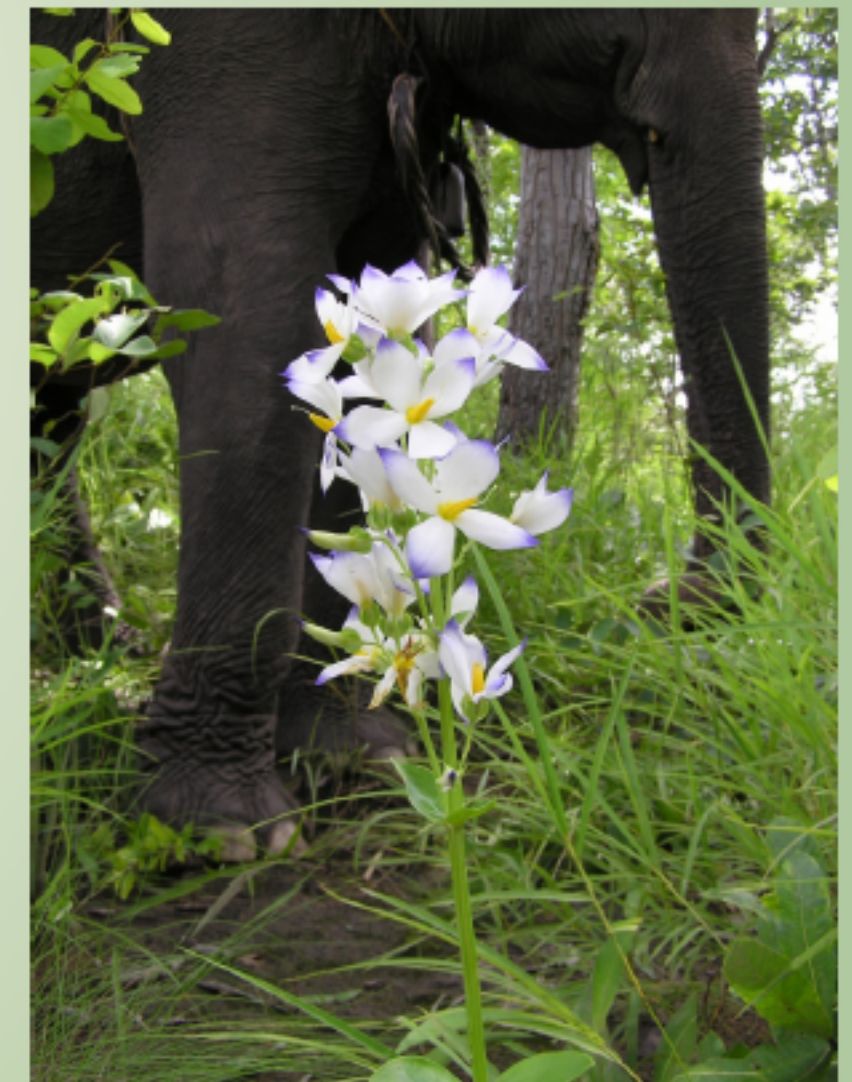
Size: 429,438ha

Objectives

- to protect and conserve all kinds of wild plant and animal species
- to maintain a balance of natural resources
- to conduct scientific and technical research
- to protect and preserve water sources
- to enhance education, extension, and community development
- to provide ecotourism services

Conservation values

- contains significant populations of important wildlife species, primarily birds and mammals
- contains habitat for globally significant wildlife species
- contains natural resources critical for local livelihoods
- protects a key watershed of the Mekong River Basin
- high potential for economic development through ecotourism
